



Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Buriram Rajabhat University (Thailand)

And

The University of Winnipeg (Canada)

The University of Winnipeg and Buriram Rajabhat University, wishing to establish relations between the two institutions, agree to cooperate with each other as follows:

Scope of the Cooperation

Subject to mutual consent, the areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either institution as thought desirable and feasible on either side and that both side think will contribute to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationship between the two universities.

Cooperation shall be carried out through such activities as, but not limited to:

- a. Exchange of faculty and/or staff
- b. Joint research activities and publications
- c. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- d. Exchange of academic materials and other information
- e. Special short-term academic programs
- f. Academic programs that may include arrangements such as dual degree, transfer agreement, 2 + 1, or 1 + 3.

The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this *Memorandum of Understanding* shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such agreements entered into, as outlined above, will form appendices to this *Memorandum of Understanding*. Each initiation shall designate a liaison officer to develop and coordinate the specific activities agree upon.
