



Memorandum of Understanding

Between

Buriram Rajabhat University, Kingdom of Thailand

And

Middle Tennessee State University, the United States of America

Buriram Rajabhat University, Kingdom of Thailand and Middle Tennessee States University, the United States of America consent to enter a formal Memorandum of Understanding (hereafter MOU), based on a foundation of mutual trust, benefit, and development of the institutions.

The two institutions wish to expand the basis for cooperation and exchange in the area of mutual interest, committing to implement the following fundamental principles.

1. The two institutions shall promote the following activities based on their respective academic and educational needs.

- 1.1 Language classes for students and the public;
- 1.2 Exchange of students;
- 1.3 Exchange of academic and administrative staff members;
- 1.4 Exchange of library materials and research publications;
- 1.5 Joint research and symposia;
- 1.6 Exchange of cultural activities;
- 1.7 Other academic exchange.

2. Details of academic cooperation resulting from this MOU will be negotiated and determined in the form of a contract signed by both parties.


3. All activities resulting from this MOU will be governed by and in accordance with the laws of Kingdom of Thailand and the United States of America. All agreements and obligations of the parties are subject to the procurement and maintenance of all applicable government consents, permits, authorizations and approval.

4. This MOU shall be governed by and in accordance with the laws of the United States of America and Kingdom of Thailand as well. All agreements and obligations of the parties set forth herein are subject to the procurement and maintenance of all applicable government consents, permits, authorities and approvals.

5. This MOU is valid for five years and is subject to revision and renewal by mutual consent. Either party may terminate the MOU at any time by written notice signed by appropriate official of party initiating the notice must be received by the other party at least six months prior to effective date of termination.

6. Any dispute or difference arising out of the interpretation on implementation of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation between the parties.

7. This agreement becomes effective when the representatives of both parties have affixed their signatures or seals to the agreement.
