Dimension of health

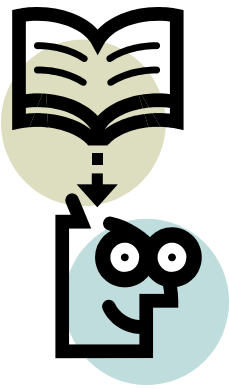
- ❖ Physical:- Systems, Organs, Disease, Defect
